Personal Property Policy

Effective January 1, 2017

In an effort to have a more consistent and cost effective policy regarding personal property assessment and taxation, the Town will no longer be sending anyone door to door to compile a list of taxable personal property. The Town will be relying on residents to self-report by completing and submitting the form provided below to the Town office by April 15th of each year. Please contact the assessors' agent or a Board Member with any questions. A new form will be required each year; for it will no longer be assumed you have ownership of previously reported property.

All tangible goods owned by residents with a current value over \$1000.00 on April 1st could be considered taxable unless an exemption or exception applies. For example; non-registered motor vehicles, farm machinery and equipment, snow plows and snow blowers are tangible goods. Residents may also refer to M.R.S. Title 36. This policy will affect residential personal property only and will have no effect on real estate or business personal property.
