WHEREAS, The Second Amendment of the United State Constitution reads: “A well-regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed.”, and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the State of Maine, Arranged by the Chief Justice of the Maine Supreme Judicial Court and approved by the Maine State Legislature, Resolve 2013, chapter 75, pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article X, Section 6, and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the State of Maine, Article I, Section 16 states, “Every citizen has a right to keep and bear arms and this right shall never be questions.”, and


WHEREAS, The Selectboard for the Town of Bradford wishes to express its deep commitment to the rights of its citizens

WHEREAS, The Selectboard for the Town of Bradford wishes to express its intent to stand as a sanctuary for the right to keep and bear arms within the limits of the Constitutions of the United States and the State of Maine, and

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Selectboard for the Town of Bradford, do hereby resolve and declare its intent to oppose unconstitutional restrictions on the right to keep and bear arms for its citizens.
